



## COVID-19 RAPID RESPONSE GRANTS GUIDELINES

The COVID-19 Rapid Response Grant will provide support to nonprofit needs as the impact unfolds. In the near term, the fund will prioritize the following services related to the increased demands as a result of COVID-19.

- The elderly and other high-risk populations
- Low income residents experiencing short term financial crisis due to loss of work/missed work (laid off, quarantined, unable to work due to lack of child care, etc.)
- Residents who are food insecure
- Supplies to support emergency response
- Residents who have no medical insurance or are under-insured
- Healthcare and emergency response workers in need of protective gear and equipment
- Physical and emotional well-being of children and youth
- Heating, water, rent and mortgage assistance

**Who Can Apply: Nonprofit organizations serving LaGrange County**  
Nonprofit Organization requests cannot exceed \$5,000

**Requirements:**  
Simple budget outline

All grant recipients are required to submit a final grant report within 30 days of completion or within a year
