

Full List of LaGrange County Community Foundation Scholarships

Note: A traditional student is a graduating high school senior, including those who are home schooled. A non-traditional student is any student that delays enrollment in post-secondary education after high school OR is currently attending a college or university.

<u>Allread-Rife Family Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship that will support a graduating senior from a LaGrange County Public High School and must be planning to pursue a degree in nursing or teaching.

<u>Amanda Lou Crotts Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a Prairie Heights High School student that is accepted in a two- or four-year college or university with the intent of pursuing a career in teaching, nursing or music and must be planning to attend full-time.

Beverly J. Todd Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Prairie Heights High School student or home-schooled student planning to pursue a career in the education field. The student must live in LaGrange or Steuben County.

Brian Evans Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Lakeland High School student who is not in the top 10 in their graduating class. Financial need is considered. FAFSA is required.

Bruce Brown Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Lakeland High School student who plans full-time enrollment in an accredited two-or four-year college, participated in sports while in high school and is ranked in the top 50% of their graduating class.

Bulldog Spirit Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Lakeland High School student who attended Wolcott Mills Elementary School and plans to be enrolled in a certificate or baccalaureate program at an accredited public or private college, university, or trade school.

<u>Chase E. Scott Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a Lakeland High School student who participated all four years in high school football and is planning full time enrollment in an accredited college, university, trade, or vocational school.

<u>Craig D & Ronda S. Neff Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a student who is a graduating senior from a LaGrange County high school and attended that school for a minimum of two years. The student must be a LaGrange County resident and participated in 4-H. Financial need is considered. FASFA is required.

<u>Ellsworth Fanning Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from the Edd's Supply Service Area (LaGrange, Elkhart, Kosciusko & Noble County) that is pursuing an education in agriculture or agricultural-related field of study including veterinary medicine. The student must plan full-time enrollment at an accredited college, university, or trade school.

<u>George O. Witwer News-Sun Journalism Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a student who has had experience or is planning an academic and professional career in journalism or a related media field (communications, digital media, video production etc.). The student must be a LaGrange County resident and a graduating senior from a LaGrange County public school, private or home school.

Holly Petersen Memorial Science Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a student planning to pursue full-time enrollment in a 4-year college or university and planning to study in some area of science. Applicant must be a graduating senior from a LaGrange County public high school, graduated in the top 33% of their class, and completed advanced science courses in high school. Financial need is considered, Preference will be given to students who attended Parkside Elementary School, and students accepted by Purdue University, or Northwestern University or Kalamazoo University, but these are not a requirement to apply for this scholarship.

HOPE Nursing Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to students who live in LaGrange County, who have had experience in the health care field and plan to enroll full-time in an accredited 2-or-4 year college, university or trade school in the field of nursing.

J.O. Mory Company Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from Lakeland, Prairie Heights or Westview that participated in the vocational construction trades and/or CAD curriculum offered through one or more of the LaGrange County School Systems. The student must plan full-time enrollment in an accredited 2-or 4- year college, university, or trade school in the construction trades area.

James F. Kalb Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Westview High School graduating senior that participated in extracurricular activities during their senior year and is planning full-time enrollment in an accredited 2- or 4- year college, university, or trade school.

Joseph J. Willard Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a LaGrange County student who attends a LaGrange County public high school and is planning to enroll full time in a nationally and regionally accredited school of engineering at a four-year college or university. Financial need is considered. FAFSA required.

Judy Gage-Keenan Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating Lakeland High school senior ranked in the top 33% of their class, who is involved in extracurricular activities or part-time work experience during high school and is planning full-time enrollment in an accredited 4-year college or university and planning to pursue a four-year bachelor's degree in the healthcare field.

<u>Keith & Arline Davis Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a Westview High School senior planning to attend full-time at a 4-year college or university and participated in sports their senior year in high school, has a GPA of at least 3.0 or higher, and served in community service and volunteer activities during their high school years.

<u>Kerry Wilt-Spradlin Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a Westview High School student that has a GPA of 3.0 or higher, participated in community service during high school and is planning to enroll full time at a 4-year college to pursue a degree in one of the following: medicine, healthcare, government, public affairs, communications, or journalism.

<u>Kevin Lewis Purdue Agriculture Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a Prairie Heights graduating senior who has attended Prairie Heights High School for at least 2 years and is planning to enroll as a full-time student at Purdue University in the School of Agriculture.

LaGrange County Farm Bureau Co-op Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior who attends a LaGrange County public school, private school or homeschool. The student must be a LaGrange County resident, have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and planning to enroll full-time in an accredited college or university to pursue a degree in agriculture, or an agriculture related filed including traditional farming, vocations in agricultural education, finance, materials and equipment supply, research, and development of agricultural products. 4-H and FFA participation preferred but not a requirement to apply.

Lakeland Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Lakeland High School student who is planning to attend an accredited college, university, or trade-school full-time.

LIFE Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior that has attended Lakeland, Prairie Heights, or Westview High School for at least the past two years and has been involved in positive community service and volunteer activities. LIFE members are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Lyle Smith Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Westview High School graduating senior who has attended Westview High School for at least two years and plans to be enrolled full time in a 2- to 4- year accredited college or university.

<u>Mary E. McGawn Future Teacher Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from Lakeland High School who has taken high school classes related to teaching (education) professions and plans to enroll full time at an accredited 4-year college or university to pursue a degree in the Education field.

<u>Mattea Holton Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a Lakeland High School senior that lives in LaGrange County, who is a U.S. citizen, has a GPA of 2.50 or higher and played girls softball all four years of high school.

<u>Melvin and Marjorie Bricker Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide 2 scholarships to graduating seniors from a LaGrange County public, private or home school. They must be a LaGrange County resident, planning to enroll full time at a 2-or 4- year college or university and must have served in a leadership position as an officer for at least one year in a LaGrange County Community Service organization. The organization can be school affiliated.

Mike Farmwald Scholarship: To provide a renewable 4-year scholarship to a graduating senior from Westview High School. The student must have attended Westview for a least two years and be planning to enroll full-time at a 2-or 4- year college or university. The student will be asked to provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher based on independent and creative thinking.

Morgan Hunter Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from Westview High School who has attended Westview High School all four years, has a minimum GPA of 2.5, participated in 4-H all four years of High School and was involved in sports or school based extracurricular activities.

Mory Family Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to graduating seniors who attend either Lakeland, Prairie Heights or Westview High School and have participated in the vocational building trades curriculum offered through one or more of the LaGrange County School Systems and who plan to enroll full-time in a trade school in the mechanical and/or electrical area.

Ned Stump Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from a LaGrange County Public School that is a legal resident of LaGrange or Steuben County, has a minimum GPA of 3.0 and is planning full-time enrollment in a 2-to-4-year accredited college, university or trade school.

<u>Olivia Bay Lemings Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a Lakeland High School graduating senior who participated in Girls Basketball all 4 years of High School.

Paul and Marian Krebs Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Lakeland High School graduating senior who has a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plans to enroll in an accredited 2-to-4-year college or university to pursue a degree in education, music, religion, or medicine-including nursing.

Perkins Family Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a Prairie Heights Student who has a minimum GPA of 2.0. Financial need is considered. FAFSA required.

<u>Prairie Heights Band Scholarship:</u> To provide a scholarship to a Prairie Heights Student who has participated in band for a minimum of 3 years.

<u>Prairie Heights Scholarship</u>: Provides four scholarships to Prairie Heights High School graduating seniors who are planning to attend an accredited 2-or-4-year college, university, or trade-school full time.

<u>Prairie Heights Student Council Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a Prairie Heights High School graduating senior that has served in a leadership position on the student council for at least two years, has a minimum GPA of 3.0 and is planning to enroll full time in an accredited 2-or-4-year college, university, or trade school.

Ray and Ruth Culp Memorial Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from a LaGrange County public, private or home school. The student must be a LaGrange County resident, participated in a professional health care training program and have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Financial need is considered. FAFSA is required.

<u>Rheinheimer Scholarship</u>: To provide a renewable 4-year scholarship to two graduating seniors from Westview High School with a minimum GPA of 3.0 that is planning to attend full-time at a 4-year college or university.

Russell Hepler Telecommunications Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior who attends Prairie Heights High School or homeschool. The student must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, participated in a telecommunications program and planning to enroll full time at a 2-or 4-year accredited public or private college or university to pursue a career in telecommunications or a related program such as digital video production, digital audio production, broadcasting, film production or digital media arts. Financial need is considered. FAFSA required.

<u>Schlemmer Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from a LaGrange County public school who plans to enroll full time in a 2-or-4-year accredited college or university or trade school. Students must have a GPA between 3.0 and 3.75.

Stan Anderson Memorial Golf Scholarship: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from Prairie Heights High School who participated in golf for at least 2 years in high school and planning to enroll in accredited 2-or-4-year college, university, or vocational/technical school.

<u>Terry Schmidt Memorial Basketball Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from Lakeland High School that participated in boys' basketball in high school and is planning to enroll full-time in an accredited 2-or 4-year college, university, or trade school.

<u>Virgil & Florence Hardin Memorial Scholarship</u>: To provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from a LaGrange County public school or homeschool. They must be a LaGrange County resident, have experience or internship in the health care filed and must plan full-time enrollment in an accredited 2-or 4-year college, university, or trade school in the healthcare field.

Waddell Scholarship: To provide a renewable 4-year scholarship to a Lakeland High School graduating senior who plans full-time enrollment in an accredited 2- or 4-year college, university, or trade school. Special consideration may be given to students pursuing a degree in journalism.
